Home inspections are important when examining the condition of a home. The intent is to verify everything is in working order, and to develop a plan to address any problems identified by the inspector. When buying or selling a home, inspections help in determining if a home accurately represents its value.

Like it or not, all Christians are ambassadors for God. At times, we may not properly represent Him in public or private places like home, work, church or the grocery store. In a culture that is very self-absorbed, it is critical that the Church accurately reflects the heart of Christ. The Church can do this by being an example of genuine community, and living out seven principles we at New Hope call the Heart Attitudes.

Reflect and pray on New Hope's Heart Attitudes listed below:

BE HUMBLE- Put the goals and interests of others above your own.

BE AUTHENTIC- Live an honest, open life before God and others.

BE TEACHABLE- Give and receive Biblical correction.

DO RECONCILE- Make relationships right.

DO SERVE - Help wherever needed.

DO GIVE- Support the church financially.

DO FOLLOW- Follow spiritual leadership within Biblical limits.

Are you able to identify one or two of these heart attitudes you could work on personally?

Create an action plan and share it with others for support and accountability.

What opportunities are available at our church and local community to help you?

Ask God for guidance and wisdom as you execute your plan courageously.

Test yourselves to make sure you are solid in the faith. Don't drift along taking everything for granted. Give yourselves regular checkups. You need firsthand evidence, not mere hearsay, that Jesus Christ is in you. Test it out. If you fail the test, do something about it.
