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**Making the most of this message (and series) will require being really honest with ourselves. Right now, ask God to help you see honestly and clearly where you are in your relationship with Him.**

**God's intention is for each of us to become more and more like Jesus in our character, values, attitudes and actions.**

Ephesians 5:1-2 (NLT)

2 Timothy 3:16-17 shows us the outline of God's plan to help us do this. Look at each part of the process and consider what you can do to grow stronger as you follow Him.

**Teaching:**

How diligent am I in learning what the Bible teaches, so I can build my life around its teaching?

When I hear a message, do I regularly follow up with the Take Home Sheet?

Do I have a good Study Bible that I can navigate fairly well? (If not ask your Small Group Leader, a staff member or check out our Marketplace this weekend.)

When I miss services, do I catch up on them? (Our website has recordings)

**Reproof:**

When I get off track from God's will, do I make excuses or admit my fault?

Do I have people in my life that love me enough to confront me when I am out of line with God's will?

Is there an area in my life (attitude or action) that I have given up on trying to change?

**Correction:**

Think about a time when you made a decision to make a change and it worked? How did it happen?

Where do I go for help when I am trying to change, so that I can honor and better follow Jesus?

On the graph, we see that getting off the path is easy (all downhill!), but making a course correction is uphill. What does that say about the importance of making corrections as soon as you are aware?

**Training:**

God doesn't expect us to be perfect, but He does want us to work hard at growing and developing as mature followers.

Read the following passage and see what you can learn about the training God has for us, and the benefits we will discover: 2 Peter 1:3-11.

Read it through several times and underline the key words and phrases. This is God's plan for us to have a full and fulfilling life!
