### Jesus set the example for me...

*For the Son of Man came to seek and save those who are lost.*

Luke 19:10 (NLT)

**He assigned to me (and all of His followers) the task of helping others cross the line of faith and become part of His team.**

<sup>18</sup> *Jesus came and told his disciples, "I have been given all authority in heaven and on earth.*

<sup>19</sup> *Therefore, go and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. <sup>20</sup> Teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you. And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age.*

Matthew 28:18-20 (NLT)

**He wants my life to be an example that would attract others to faith in Him.**

*In the same way, let your good deeds shine out for all to see, so that everyone will praise your heavenly Father.*

Matthew 5:16 (NLT)

**I am His ambassador and representative.**

<sup>17</sup> *Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come!*

<sup>18</sup> *All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation: <sup>19</sup> that God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting men's sins against them. And he has committed to us the message of reconciliation. <sup>20</sup> We are therefore Christ's ambassadors, as though God were making his appeal through us. We implore you on Christ's behalf: Be reconciled to God.*

2 Corinthians 5:17-20 (NIV)

**Even if I am misunderstood or ridiculed, He wants me to carry on!**

<sup>14</sup> *So be happy when you are insulted for being a Christian, for then the glorious Spirit of God rests upon you. <sup>15</sup> If you suffer, however, it must not be for murder, stealing, making trouble, or prying into other people's affairs. <sup>16</sup> But it is no shame to suffer for being a Christian. Praise God for the privilege of being called by his name!*

1 Peter 4:14-16 (NLT)
