New Hope Men...We're Going Camping!

New Hope Men's Ministry is hosting an overnight camping retreat on June 17/18 at Prince William Forest Park. Join us for a weekend of fellowship, worship, hiking, fishing, golfing, bonfires, hamburgers and hotdogs. Our guest speaker for this event is Cedric Owens of New Hope Church in Durham, NC. Having led his church's Men's Life Group and served on the prison ministry team, Cedric will share his unique perspective on how we can reach our full potential as authentic, Christian men.

Prince William Forest Park, just 15 miles from New Hope, is the largest protected natural area in the DC Metro area, with over 19,000 acres. Although you're welcome to pitch a tent, our campsite contains over 25 cabins with beds for 148 men. All you will need is a sleeping bag and a pillow. Think more of Cloverbud Camp at the 4-H Center rather than Man Vs. Wild. You will not need to catch your own food or create your own shelter.

We'll get started on Friday at 3 pm and finish by Saturday at 4 pm. The cost is \$50 per person, which covers food and accommodations. Greens fee for golf is not included in this figure and will cost an additional \$39. Must be over 18 to attend. Sign up today at one of the kiosks in the atrium or at the links listed below. 
