## Message:

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## The Point:

You are famous because of who you know not who knows you

## Goals:

Cultivate a personal relationship with the students

Discuss with students the human desire for fame

Have students recognize the areas that they don't let God have

Engage in personal prayer requests

Have fun!

## How to use Talk It Over:

Talking through the message during the week helps you and your group turn what God is saying to you into action steps. Begin with the key questions, add any optional scriptures and questions if needed, and then wrap up by deciding on your next steps.

## Key Questions:

Who is the most famous person you have ever met?

Who is a famous person you would like to meet?

Why do many people desire to be famous? Would you like being famous?

## Optional Questions: If needed, include one or more of these scriptures and questions to extend your conversation.

What are some things that you do to get attention?

Why doesn't being known by God seem like enough for most Christians?

What does "glory" mean to you?

What are ways that you live for your own glory? What are the ways that you live for God's glory?


How can you stop seeking the spotlight for yourself and start shining it on Jesus by how you live?
